- **Grand River Cellars** – Located in the heart of the Grand River Valley Wine Region, grape production is often at its premium allowing for production of varietal wines. The group will enjoy a tour, winetasting and lunch at Grand River Cellars Winery.
- **Ferrante Winery** - Tucked into the heart of the vineyards, they offer a luscious contemporary oak-laden atmosphere. We will visit the tasting bar to sample a range nationally award winning red, white and blush wines.
- **East Coast Original Frozen Custard** – Enjoy an ice cream cone (included in the package).
