- **Phipps Conservatory and Botanical Gardens** – brings together the finest in horticulture art, education and fun something blooming at Phipps!
- **Pittsburgh Creche (pictured above)** the creche is a larger-than-life nativity scene and the world's only replica of the Vatican's St. Peter's Square display in Rome.
- **Wintergarden PPG and the PPG Plaza** - If Downtown Pittsburgh is the epicenter of holiday activity, then PPG Place is at its heart. Wintergarden is located in a plant-filled, all-glass atrium and features life-sized Santa Claus figures dressed in traditional costumes from countries around the world. It is also home of the Community Gingerbread House Display (over 500 of them) and a 32-foot decorated Christmas tree with a model train display around its base. In the nearby plaza, see the Pittsburgh Ice Rink which encircles a 65-foot decorated Christmas tree.
